Introduction

ICC Austin requires a substantial commitment from individual members to maintain and operate the houses. Teaching the ICC Austin responsibilities to new members is essential to well-run houses, and takes time. Because ICC Austin is not well-equipped to provide transient housing, and because short-term members often disrupt house function, ICC Austin maintains a minimum contract length policy.

The policy is intended to balance the need to provide flexibility in the summer to maximize occupancy with the need to have houses filled with a stable, invested membership.

Definitions

A "contract" is an executed Member Resident Agreement.

Policy

- 1. Contracts signed for the academic year must be for the entire or remaining semester term.
- 2. Contracts signed for the summer term must be for at least one month (30 days).

Procedure

1. The Membership Director will ensure that member contracts are for a term no less than the minimum contract length.
